PINOT GRIS TRADITION 2015

Origin and location: Herrenweg in Turckheim, Alsace.

Soil composition: its terroir is made of fine sand, silt and large pebbles.

Yield: 51 hl/ha

Production 200 cases

Acidity: 3,33 H2S04

Sugar: 21 g/l

Alcohol: 12,90 %

100% Biodynamic: Biodyvin certification.

Vinification and aging:
Pressing of the grapes is 100%
whole cluster. They undergo a very slow and gradual pressing.

Natural decantation (settling period)
after 14 hours of rest. Indeginous
yeasts are used, fermentations
(thermoregulated) are cool and long.
The wine is racked of the gross lees
and allowed to age on the fine lees until bottling.

The wine is aged in 150-year-old French oak barrels (foudre de chene)until the bottling in July.
